



The Elham Valley Line Trust welcomes visitors of all abilities.

Most of our site is accessible to wheelchairs and pushchairs.

Assistance dogs are welcome throughout the site, including the Tea Room.

George's Barn

Two accessible parking spaces are provided in the top left-hand corner of the car park. These spaces can easily be taken, but do not worry. It is normally only on special occasions that the car park is full.

The mezzanine is accessible via a stair lift.

There is an Accessible Toilet available along with Ladies and Gentlemen's.

Tangled Trail

The trail has several steep sections and can be uneven under foot. It is usable by wheelchairs and pushchairs with care.

An alternative route to the Museum is available, leaving the Barn by the side gate and walking up the road. Be careful because there is no footpath, and though a 30 mile per hour limit, cars speed.

Railway Museum

The majority of the railway Museum is accessible, except for three exhibits.

The signal box and replica locomotive have three steps to reach them, whilst the "Ticket Office" has one step.

Miniature Train Rides

Our carriages do not accept wheelchairs, but assistance can be given in transferring to the carriage and vice versa.

Mobile Phone Access

Mobile phone coverage is generally good throughout the whole site.
